BO Pharaoh still stubbornly refuses to let the Israelites go. The final plagues of locusts, darkness and the death of the firstborn come upon the Egyptians. Pharaoh finally relents and lets the Israelites go. God tells Moses and Aaron that they will depart from Egypt in the first month and that on the tenth day of the month each Israelite household should acquire a lamb. At twilight on the fourteenth day each household should slaughter their lamb, putting some of its blood on the doorposts so that their houses are spared the plague of the death of the firstborn. The Israelites must also eat unleavened bread (matzah) for seven days. God commands Moses to establish the festival of Pesach. The Israelites are commanded to tell their children about the meaning of Pesach –which means telling them about the meaning of freedom itself. God gives Moses the laws of the Pesach sacrifice. The Israelites are further told to consecrate their firstborn to God, as a further remembrance of their departure from Egypt.
