CHAYEI SARA Abraham's wife Sarah dies. Devoted Abraham buys a burial place for Sarah, outside the future city of Hebron. The site-the cave of Machpelah, which became the burial place for all the Patriarchs and Matriarchs, with the exception of Rachel, Jacob's wife. With her death, Abraham realizes that he's not going to be around forever. He knows that Isaac needs a wife, and so he sends his servant back to Aram-naharaim to find one for him. The servant returns home with Rebekah. Abraham marries again and has more children. When Abraham dies his sons Isaac and Ishmael bury him in the cave of Machpelah with Sara. They don't have anything to say to each other but at least they are together again. Sometimes, rifts in families can heal.
