DEVARIM Encamped in Moab (just across the Jordan River from the Promised Land) and one month away from death, Moses begins a series of lengthy discourses to the entire Israelite population. His first speech recalls the events that lead the generation of the Exodus to wander for 40 vears rather than entering Canaan expediently. Unlike in the account in the book of Numbers, Moses says that the people, not God, insist on sending chiefs into the land, leading to the negative reports that cause the Israelites to panic and delays the conquest of Canaan. The remainder



of this portion details how the subsequent generation of Israelites, 38 years later, are able to make their way through their wanderings by either evading or defeating the other nations in their midst. This generation is far more ready and willing to follow God's instructions, and thus is deemed ready to enter the Promised Land.
