**KI TEITZEI** Dozens of rules are explained in this portion. Many involve rules of family: the accumulation of new wives, rewarding deserving children and punishing disobedient children, Levirate marriage, and basic guidelines of divorce and re-marriage. Some involve personal intimacy: adultery, prostitution, and premarital relations. Some involve ritual purity: such as limits on who may enter the Divine sanctuary, wearing appropriate clothes, and not using mixed seeds and textiles. Others involve limits on punishment: administering lashes to people and pain to animals. Still others speak of economic matters: including paying wages in a timely fashion, caring for the poor and dealing honestly in business. The parasha culminates in the national imperative to remember Amalek and to completely wipe it out from the earth
