**PINCHAS** After zealously stopping the Israelite plague at Baal-Peor, Pinchas is rewarded with a Divine covenant of friendship, which will be passed down to his priestly descendants. God commands Moses to defeat the Midianites for their role in the Israelites' recent idolatry. Moses and Eleazar, the High Priest, are commanded to take a census of Israelites aged 20 and over -- an accounting of the children of the Exodus generation. Only Joshua and Caleb will experience both the Exodus and the conquest of Canaan. The five daughters of Zelophehad ask that the inheritance of their father -- who did not have a son -- be handed to them. God grants the request, setting a future precedent. Knowing that his days are numbered, Moses asks God to assign a successor. Following God's directive, Moses lays his hands upon Joshua, ordaining him as the next human Israelite leader. The details of sacrificial offerings for Shabbat, Rosh Hodesh, Passover, Shavuot, Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, Sukkot and Shmini Atzeret are outlined.
