

VAERA God reveals a new divine name to Moses, Yud Heh Vav Heh, pronounced *Adonai*. Moses insists that he has trouble speaking, which will make it very difficult for him to lead the Israelites out of Egypt. Moses and Aaron get into a war of magical powers with the magicians of Egypt to see who has the most power—the God of the Israelites, or the gods of the Egyptians. God brings the first plagues upon the Egyptians. The Nile turns to blood; frogs appeared, lice, swarms of insects, cattle disease, boils and hail. Throughout it all, Pharaoh’s heart is “hardened”, which means that he is unable to make the wise decision to let the Israelites go, although he does come close a few times.
