

VAYAKHEL-PEKUDEI Moses expands upon the earlier commandment regarding Shabbat, as found in the Ten Commandments. Whoever does any work shall be put to death, and kindling fire is considered a violation of Shabbat. Moses reminds the Israelites that they should bring donations for the construction of the Tabernacle, and he gives specific instructions about the materials. Moses' directions



emphasize the role of the heart: gifts must come from "everyone whose heart so moves him": and those who are skilled should be involved in the project. There is a particular role for women as well—as spinners and weavers. Moses showcases the talent of Bezalel and Oholiab, who are master craftsmen of the Tabernacle. The people bring an overabundance of gifts to the building of the Tabernacle, and their gift giving has to be stopped. There is a detailed account of the weight and value of all the gold and silver used in the construction of the Tabernacle. There is a detailed description of all materials used in the priestly garments. Moses sets up the Tabernacle as God had commanded. The language used in describing this project *work completed* and *blessed*-echoes the language of the book of Genesis used when God created the world. God's cloud, a visible sign of God's presence, descends upon the Tabernacle and becomes a signal for the People of Israel to move forward on their journey through the wilderness.






