VAYECHI Jacob, nearing death, asks Joseph to bury him in Canaan, then later adopts and blesses Joseph's sons, Ephraim and Manasseh. Jacob then offers final words to his sons (some of them harsh, others filled with blessing. Jacob dies, and the brothers bury him in the Cave of Machpelah. The brothers fear, once again, that Joseph will take revenge on them for selling him into slavery years before. Joseph reassures them, once again, that God meant for things to happen the way they did. Joseph dies and is embalmed, with his brothers promising that he, too, would be buried in Canaan.
